

Tropical Storm and Hurricane Prep for Elevators

Help keep your passengers safe and prepare your elevator equipment in advance of a tropical storm or hurricane



Before and During

- If safe access is available, close or cover all vents and openings into the elevator hoistway and machine room to prevent water from entering.
- ▶ If an elevator opens to the outdoors, remove elevator from service and then place sandbags along all exposed hoistway doors.
- Run all elevators to the top floor to reduce component damage in the event of a water intrusion.
- Remove elevator from service. Confirm all elevator doors are closed.
- Do not operate an elevator during a tropical storm or hurricane to remove the potential for passenger entrapments.



After

- Water that comes into contact with elevator components can cause rusting and corrosion that can lead to erratic elevator operation, equipment shutdowns, passenger entrapments, and component failures.
- Have your elevator equipment reviewed by your maintenance provider after a tropical storm or hurricane for any water intrusion or potential component damage.
